- Contributed \$300 of the pledged \$1200 for Fr Gregory's mission in Africa.
- Contributed \$1000 to the Alabama State K of C Seminarian fund.
- Contributed \$500 to the youth group to support their activities
- Prepared numerous meals for the youth group, March Deanery Priest's Meeting and other organizations
- Donated \$300 to Enterprise Special Olympics Games and "booster team" to cheer for competing athletes
- Purchased and supplied flowers to mothers on Mother's Day at St. John and St. Mary
- Sponsored a Parish rosary celebration and Council Corporate Communion
- Contributed \$148.00, in the form of food, to the Mental Disabilities Center (Purvis Center), Geneva
- Supported the Parish picnic with food and "dunk booth."
